Dear Pet Owner: Township Ordinance No. 13-1992 requires that every person who owns, possesses, keeps or harbors any cat, dog or potentially dangerous dog of licensing age within the limits of the Township shall obtain an annual license for the same and shall have the same registered and numbered with the Township Clerk. Any owner of a dog or cat of licensing age (dog 7 months) (cat 6 months) who shall bring the same into the Township which dog or cat has been licensed in another state for the current year and bears a registration tag, and who shall keep the same or permit the same to be kept with the Township for a period of more than 90 days, shall immediately after the 90th day apply for a license and registration tag for the same. Any Person who shall bring or cause to be brought into the Township any unlicensed dog or cat of licensing age (dog 7 months) (cat 6 months) and shall keep the same or permit the same to be kept within the Township for a period of more than 10 days shall immediately after the 10th day apply for a license and registration tag for such dog or cat.

Registering Your Pet: Licenses are due by January 31st. You may purchase the licenses at the Municipal Building from the Municipal Clerk's office between the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. **Before**

licensing, check the rabies vaccination expiration dates for your pets. If vaccination expires prior to November 1st, dogs and cats must be re-vaccinated. You may renew licenses by mail. If you renew by mail, just give us your pet(s) previous license number and send current rabies vaccination certificate(s), correct fees and a stamped, self-addressed envelope to return your documents with your new license(s). For first time licensing, fill out the attached Registration Form and submit correct fees, etc. same as above.

License fee for sterilized dogs is \$8.20 and \$11.20 if not. The license fee for sterilized cats is \$2.00 and \$5.00 if not. If dogs and cats are spayed or neutered, present a statement from your veterinarian indicating your pet(s) has been sterilized in order to receive the \$3.00 deduction in the license fees. If license(s) are not purchased by March 31st a late fee of \$10 will be assessed for each license issued after this date. ***Please license your pets by the March 31st deadline to avoid summonses and court fines. The annual dog/cat census will begin on or about April 15th.***

Again, check the rabies vaccination expiration dates for your pets. If vaccination expires prior to November 1st, dogs and cats must be re-vaccinated. The New Jersey State Department of Health has issued a strong recommendation that we not issue new licenses if rabies vaccinations expire prior to November 1st of the licensing year. Even though a rabies vaccination is certified for three (3) years, the State recommends

vaccinations be given every two (2) years to protect your pets and family members.

Free Rabies Clinic: The Township is having a **Free Rabies Clinic** in the Harrison Township Municipal Garage behind the Municipal Building on **Saturday, March 13, 2010.** Dogs will be vaccinated from 9:00 a.m. until 10:15 a.m. and Cats will be vaccinated from 10:15 until 11:00 a.m. Licenses can be purchased in the Clerk's Office at that time.
