Corrections/Approval of September 23rd Sports Minutes - Jack McElwee made a motion to approve, 2nd by Vince Gangemi. All in favor.

- **PLEASANT VALLEY FOOTBALL** – John DiFelice – Everything is going good. Working on proposal to be submitted. Needs civil plans from township.
- **HARRISON TWP. SOCCER** – Jack McElwee – Meeting w/ Administrator on Saturday to review concession stand & placement of soda machines. Also the asphalt path splitting the fields. Veterans Memorial dedication at William Wilt is scheduled for Saturday, November 8th at 11:00AM.
- **HARRISON TWP. LITTLE LEAGUE** – Frank Lengetti – Baseball will be through on October 31st. Over 120 kids this year. Frank will submit a letter requesting lights again next year from March 1st through October 31st. Frank inquired about the procedure for requesting usage of the fields. Vince thought years ago it was written to be 2/3 of the team requesting being Harrison Twp. residents. Jack responded that he is working on a policy and will be consulting with Brian Duffield, township solicitor so that we are doing things correctly. Frank also questioned the concession stand. Who it actually belongs to.
- **CLEARVIEW LACROSSE** – Steve Martin – Submitted request for field usage for spring lacrosse at Pleasant Valley.
- **HARRISON TWP. HAWKS** – Brad Quast – 4 successful dates at Rowan. 3 teams made playoffs – 2 teams made regional. They will be requesting field space again for next fall.

The Mayor wanted to reinforce the indent to use the revenue generated from the additional 4 cents to develop township owned space. Once the open space has been developed any monies left over would be used for maintenance and the purchase of land if required.
