

ORDINANCE NO. 11-2010

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF
REAL PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS BLOCK 37, LOT 3 AND BLOCK 59, LOT 5 ON THE
MUNICIPAL TAX MAP OF HARRISON TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the County of Gloucester is the owner of Block 37, Lot 3 and Block 59, Lot 5 located in the Township of Harrison; and

WHEREAS, Block 37, Lot 3 and Block 59, Lot 5 consists of approximately 85.86 ± acres; and

WHEREAS, the County of Gloucester has indicated a desire to donate and transfer the property to the Township of Harrison to be preserved in perpetuity as open space for conservation and recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the location and characteristics of Block 37, Lot 3 and Block 59, Lot 5 provide the Township of Harrison with much needed passive recreation and open spaces in close proximity to the William Wilt Memorial Soccer Complex and Pleasant Valley School athletic fields; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the residents of the Township of Harrison to accept the donation and acquire Block 37, Lot 3 and Block 59, Lot 5 from the County of Gloucester.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

1. The acquisition by donation from the County of Gloucester of the real property identified on the Township of Harrison Tax Map as Block 37, Lot 3 and Block 59, Lot 5 is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk are further authorized to execute any and all Amendments, Addendums or any other documents to effectuate the purposes hereof.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
