

ORDINANCE NO. 24-2011

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.
03-2011 ENTITLED "SEWERS, SECTION 11 ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE"
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments to Ordinance 03-2011 adopted February 22, 2011 are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Ordinance 03-2011 shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

§170-11. entitled "Annual Service Charge" shall be amended to read as follows:

**SCHEDULE 3
SERVICE CHARGES – UNMETERED SERVICES**

B. DEMAND CHARGE

1. Rates:

CLASS 1: RESIDENTIAL, per unit (Single-family homes, condominiums, townhouses, apartments, multifamily, duplex, age restricted, trailers, mobile homes)

Annual Charge: ~~\$444.00~~ \$675.00 per unit

C. PRESUMED USAGE CHARGE

CLASS 1: Each residential unit having an unmetered water supply shall not be billed at the a Usage Charge. ~~established for Class 1 customers in Schedule 2, based on a presumed usage of 27,000 gallons per quarter.~~

Section 2.

The January 1, 2011 Sanitary Sewer Rate Schedule shall be amended to read as follows:

**SCHEDULE 3
SERVICE CHARGES – UNMETERED SERVICES**

B. DEMAND CHARGE

1. Rates:

CLASS 1: RESIDENTIAL, per unit (Single-family homes, condominiums, townhouses, apartments, multifamily, duplex, age restricted, trailers, mobile homes)

Annual Charge: ~~\$444.00~~ \$675.00 per unit

C. PRESUMED USAGE CHARGE

CLASS 1: Each residential unit having an unmetered water supply shall not be billed at the a Usage Charge established for Class 1 customers in Schedule 2, based on a presumed usage of 27,000 gallons per quarter.

Section 3.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 4.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
