MINUTES

OPENING: Mayor Louis Manzo called the meeting to order at 5:09 p.m., which was held at the Municipal Building.

ROLL CALL: Diane Malloy, Municipal Clerk, called the roll which resulted in the following: Present: Deputy Mayor Clowney; Committee Member Heim; Mayor Manzo.

Others present: Carole Rieck, Administrator, Thomas Mills, Chief of Police.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT ANNOUNCEMENT: Ms. Malloy read the following statement: “In compliance with Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of 1975, notice of this meeting was given by way facsimile notice and mailed notice, filed with the Gloucester County Times and the Courier Post newspapers and posted on the bulletin board in the municipal building on September 19, 2011”.

FLAG SALUTE: Mayor Manzo called for a moment of recognition for our troops, followed by the flag salute.
