Vince Gangemi, Sr. led members in Pledge of Allegiance.

Corrections/Approval for October 26, 2005 meeting minutes – there were no corrections and commission approved minutes.

Guest: Frank Lengetti (Little League).

Little League report as follows:

- A request was made by Frank for 2 additional keys for the outside doors and 3 additional keys for the metal doors upstairs. Giving him a total of 10 keys for each. A memo was sent to Mike in Public Works for this request. (please see attached Memo).
- Proclamation Day dates as follows: December 5th, 19th, or 27th. A suggestion for December 5th was made by Vince due to the Holidays. Frank will be emailing the coaches to see what date best suits the children so the majority can attend.
- A meeting is being discussed regarding the outdoor lights at Ella Harris Field. Due to the request being removed from the agenda twice, Frank has suggested a meeting with the lighting company MUSCO, the Mayor, the Administrator for the township Carole, and Vince from the Recreation commission along with himself and the other members of the Board of Directors for Little League be scheduled. The tentative dates for this meeting are November 30th, or December 1st. MUSCO will determine the date due to their inconvenience.
- The fields in question are: the lighting of fields 1 & 2, and an area behind the fields.
- Frank made a suggestion to have a comparison done of the real estate around other fields that have lights regarding property values. Also to see what other fields in the district have lights.
- Sports registration forms will be available in the Recreation office after the holidays for those interested in signing out for sports. Only the children who do not go to public school in Harrison will need a registration form mailed to them.
